About the Community

BuiltHub is fostering a Europe-wide community interested in knowledge about the EU building stock and its transition.

The project engages with a Community of Stakeholders to:

The Community's needs and technical requirements have been collected and assessed through a literature review and direct feedback via surveys and interviews. The result of which fed into the development of the BuiltHub Platform, as well as its data assembly, processing and analysis services and business cases.

About the Platform

The project is developing an inclusive data collection and valorisation method via an accessible web-based Platform enabling a succinct assessment of Europe's building stock. It will support a long-lasting flow of data through a benefits-based engagement strategy.

The BuiltHub Platform is a repository for building and energyrelated data and metadata. It draws on and feeds into existing data sets and repositories, such as the EU Building Stock Observatory, Horizon 2020 projects, CORDEX, IEE TABULA, and more. The Platform includes datasets, clustered into three main categories: building stock related, socio-economic and climatic.

Using various dashboards and graphs, users can visually view data and geoinformation relating to construction, renovation and energy consumption. The data can be sorted and displayed according to the following, and more:
