What we do

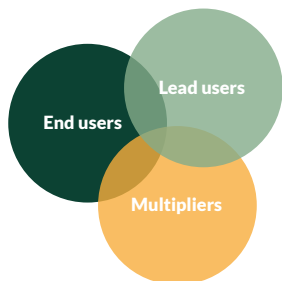
- Establish an active community of data providers and users, including projects, initiatives, individuals and other stakeholders

The community and platform are comprised of beneficiaries and contributors, each with varying knowledge, interests and goals.

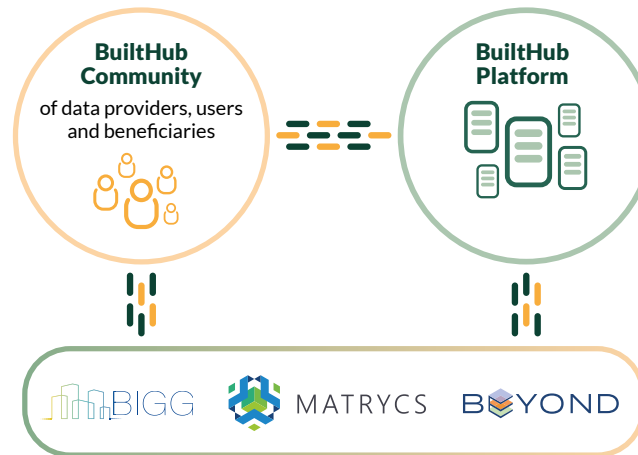


About the platform
